Renovation of the The View play area, Bankside Lane, Rawtenstall

description of work carried out

This project comprised levelling the site, installing a revised drainage system, custom designed furniture and the construction of a ramp which was DDA compliant to provide access to the play area.

The new disability access was constructed sympathetically, incorporating a stone wall in keeping with the existing boundary walls.

After levelling was complete a tarmac base was laid ready for the resin bound coloured gravel surface, which was laid by hand to achieve the smooth curves required to fulfil the design specification.

To complete the project, flower beds were planted with appropriate robust sensory plants.
